

The Three Hierarchs

Scholarship Awards



The Three Hierarchs Scholarship awards of Drs Anthony and Joyce Kales was established in 1993 at St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church, Ann Arbor Michigan.

The purpose of the award is to **recognize, and thereby, stimulate outstanding academic achievement.**

Each year, at the beginning of May, all graduating high school seniors with these qualifications should request the application with accompanying documents listed in the brochure.

To be eligible for this award, students must:

- 1) **Be graduating high school senior;** and
- 2) **Have attained a high level of academic achievement.**

In addition, their family must be members of good standing with St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church of Ann Arbor, Michigan.

The Three Hierarchs Scholarship Awards Committee will evaluate a student's academic performance by considering the student's overall record according to the following academic criteria and standards.

Criteria and Standards

1. Membership in the National Honor Society;
2. A grade point average of 3.5 or above (when scale is 4.0 or an A) or its equivalent, and
3. If taken, a combined SAT score in Verbal and Math of 1320 or greater for college-bound seniors.

The **Scholarship Awards Committee** shall be appointed by the St. Nicholas Parish Council president and will be comprised of three members.

The Scholarship Awards Program

In keeping with the teachings of our Orthodox faith and tradition, the program has been named "The Three Hierarchs Scholarship Awards." The Three Hierarchs of our church, **St. Basil the Great, St. Gregory the Theologian and St. John Chrysostom** are considered the patron saints of education and culture, because they used the art of education and the Greek classics to teach about God.

Once having received scholarship awards as graduating high school students, awards recipients are eligible for three additional yearly scholarship awards while in college. These awards are contingent on their maintaining an annual or cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or higher in the freshman, sophomore and junior years.

The Funds for this program will be administered by a Wealth Management Firm with the direction of the St. Nicholas Parish Council. The annual awards will be determined based on the 5-year average Fund returns.

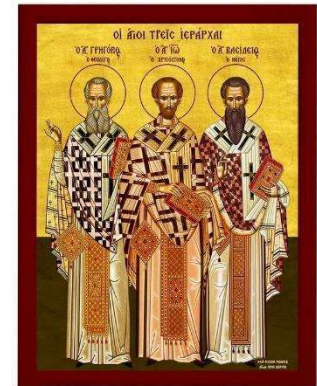
